Director's Report Great Falls Public Library Board of Trustees Meeting October 21, 2013

- 1. **Margo Smith**, a longtime patron, has donated a bronze sculpture to the library. The title of the piece is "Memories of Tomorrow's Past", based on a poem written by the artist, Kate Hiddleston and which the girl in the sculpture is reading. Please stop by the lobby and take a look. It's a beautiful piece and most appropriate for the library.
- 2. Last month the **Foundation** approved \$27,000 in support to the library which will fund adult, juvenile and young adult materials, shelving for the fiction room, new fax machine and additional Ready to Read Literacy kits.
- 3. October 6 was our first **Sunday**, with a foot traffic count of 299. October 13 saw 345 patrons coming into the library. It typically takes a number of weeks for people to get used to the library being open on Sundays, which then becomes one of our busiest days due to the 4-hour schedule.
- 4. We are applying for a grant through NeighborWorks to help fund a Little Free Libraries project. I have met with Marty Basta of Park & Recreation, the Park & Recreation Board and some members of the Friends of the Library, who are all in support of the project. I have included information in your packet about the project and will discuss in further detail at our meeting.
- 5. Wednesday, October 16 was the first day of the **AAUW Booksale**. As in years past, there were people lined up beginning at 10:00. The booksale didn't start until 12:00! We hope they have another very successful year.
