

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Sue Dickenson has demonstrated outstanding leadership and community service to the City of Great Falls and the State of Montana; and

WHEREAS, she was elected in 2002 to the Montana House of Representatives and served terms in the 58th, 59th, 60th, and 61st sessions of the legislature; and

WHEREAS, Representative Dickenson sponsored House Bill Number 540 in 2005, which provided \$11 million for a new addition to the Great Falls Vocational Technical Center, and allowed students to access an affordable and quality higher education and met the need to supply an educated workforce for community businesses; and

WHEREAS, Sue Dickenson was first elected in 1978 to serve as a member of the Great Falls Neighborhood Council 3 and has served a total of four terms on the council as chair or vice-chair; and

WHEREAS, Sue Dickenson completed a stellar career in education as a teacher in Great Falls Public Schools from 1967 to 1971, as a substitute teacher for the school district from 1971 to 1993, as the head teacher for the Meadowlark Elementary School HANDS Program from 1994 to 1995, and as a night school teacher for the district; and

WHEREAS, Sue Dickenson also volunteered to serve for many local boards and organizations to include KGPR Great Falls Public Radio, Our Savior's Lutheran Church, the Committee of the '80s, the Cascade County Government Study Commission, and Great Falls Rising.


