2.	<p>Commission Action - Set Public Hearing Resolution of Intent to call for a mail-in election authorizing the city to exceed the mill levy limit established by MCA 15-10-420.</p> <p>Authorization – election required to exceed maximum mill levy. (1) The governing body shall pass a resolution indicating its intent to exceed the current statutory mill levy limit on the approval of a majority of the qualified electors voting in an election. The resolution must include: (a) the specific purpose for which the additional money will be used; (b) the specific dollar amount to be raised; and (c) the approximate number of mills required. (1) A local government election must be held on the same day as the primary election or the general election, except that an election concerning funding may be called as a special election.</p> <p>(2) A local government election <u>may not be held sooner than 85 days after the date of the adopted resolution calling for an election.</u></p> <p>(3) The resolution shall specify that the election be conducted by mail.</p>	MCA 13-1-405	85 days = May 13, 2020 May 27, 2020 (Ok = June 2, 2020 primary is after these dates)	85 days = September 9 September 30 (Ok=November 3 general is after these dates)
5.	<p>Initiation by governing body. (1) By resolution of the governing body addressed to the election administrator, request that a particular election be conducted.</p> <p>(2) No later than 70 days before election day, the governing body shall transmit its request to the election administrator</p>	MCA 13-19-202 (Mail Ballot Election)	70 days = March 24, 2020	70 days = August 25, 2020
