Mayor Kelly Commissioners Robinson, Moe, Houck and Tryon City of Great Falls

Dear Great Falls City Commission,

I am writing on behalf of Rivers Edge Trail Foundation to ask for you votes in favor of the two proposed subdivisions and resulting land exchange at the South end of Ninth and Tenth Street Bridges. This proposal is the result of years of work and negotiations by City staff, project stakeholders and dedicated volunteers. The exchange benefits Independence Bank and the people of Great Falls equally.

The proposed Subdivision of City property to be transferred to Independence Bank will be used for more parking spaces along the South side of the Bank property. These spaces are intended for use both by Bank customers and by River's Edge Trail users. The proposed Independence Bank Subdivision transfers land along the Missouri River to City ownership which will ultimately be used to realign River's Edge Trail from the Ninth Street Underpass to the Tenth Street Bridge Abutment. When complete, the new alignment will improve safety by eliminating a dangerous corner at the Ninth Street Underpass, provide permanent trail access to the South end of the Tenth Street Bridge (The bridge will provide a safer and more enjoyable river crossing at that location) and enhance trail user experiences along that stretch of River's Edge Trail.

With approval of these subdivision proposals and land exchange, River's Edge Trail Foundation can continue to work with the City to develop shovel ready realignment plans and seek funding for construction. We at River's Edge Trail Foundation urge you to vote in favor of both mutually beneficial subdivisions and the associated land exchange.


