These comments are to alert you to some infrastructure issues at Anaconda Hills Golf Course. I'm informed the items in question are still City responsibility.

1) The approach road to the parking lot around the driving range is a potholed mess. There's no way to avoid hitting several on the way in. I don't know of another City park access road or parking lot in such poor condition.

2) The screening on the north side of the driving range has huge gaps and holes that allow errant practice shots to fly out into the parking lot, to potentially strike vehicles and/or people. That's a huge lawsuit in the making.

Everyone in town pays taxes to support our City parks, even golfers who don't use any of the other parks. The golf courses should not be neglected, especially since unlike most of the the other parks they do generate some revenue for the City, if nothing else paying down past debt.
