Education - HiSET, college prep & placement



**Employment** – Job training, OJT, vocational programs



Medical Care – MAT, psychiatric meds, dental & health services



Counseling – Trauma-informed therapy for individuals & families



Family Reunification - Plans to safely return children home



Individualized Support – Tailored case plans built with each participant

## **Montana Impact**

67.7% Graduation rate

- at or above the national overage

1.743 participants served

(Nov 2020 - Oct 2024)

81.3% increase in full-time employment from admission

to graduation

### Why It Matters

Cost Savings – Treatment courts reduce taxpayer costs vs. incarceration

Public Safety – Lower recidivism, stronger families, safer communities

Urgency – Cuts to Mdicaid/VA subsidies make treatment courts more vital than ever
