## What Treatment Courts Do



Education – HiSET, college prep & placement



Employment – Job training, OJT, vocational programs



Medical Care – MAT, psychiatric meds, dental & health services



Counseling – Trauma-informed therapy for individuals & families



Family Reunification – Plans to safely return children home



Individualized Support – Tailored case plans built with each participant

## Montana Impact

(Legislative Report, 2025)

**67.7% Graduation rate**

– at or above the national average

**1,743 participants served**

(Nov 2020 – Oct 2024)

**81.3% increase in full-time employment** from admission to graduation

## Why It Matters

**Cost Savings** – Treatment courts reduce taxpayer costs vs. incarceration

**Public Safety** – Lower recidivism, stronger families, safer communities

**Urgency** – Cuts to Medicaid/VA subsidies make treatment courts more vital than ever
