Fiscal Services Director Melissa Kinzler provided a PowerPoint presentation of FY 2014 General Fund preliminary revenue projections and expense outlook.

FY 2014 General Fund **Revenue Projections**

- Property Tax Revenue
 - Tax Year 2014 1.03% inflation adjustment (\$134,366)
 - Commission Action/ Public Hearing required
 - Projected Historical Average FY 2007 to FY 2013 (\$330,000), estimating \$200,000 based on last vear
 - Overall minimal increase estimated
 - \$334,366 projected total increase FY 2014

FY 2014 General Fund **Revenue Projections**

- · Other Revenue
 - HB 124 "Big Bill" State Entitlement Payments -**NOW HB 495**
 - \$6.9 million in State Entitlement Payments FY 2013
 - Four quarterly equal payments (not all General Fund)
 - Had 3.5% increase in Governor's Budget for FY 2014
 - \$230,304 projected increase in General Fund

FY 2014 General Fund **Revenue Projections**

- · Other Revenue
 - Local Option Vehicle Tax (.5%)
 - \$1,110,000 estimated, \$1,110,000 budgeted in FY 2013
 - Projected increase for FY 2014 in budget \$0
 - · Annually extended by the County

FY 2014 General Fund **Revenue Projections**

- · Other Revenue
 - Fines & Forfeitures Revenue
 - \$1.2 million estimated in FY 2013
 - No projected increase in FY 2014
