



**Item:** Appointment, Business Improvement District Board of Trustees

**Action Requested:** Appoint one member to the Business Improvement District Board of Trustees to fill the remainder of a four-year term through June 30, 2016.

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**Suggested Motion:**

**Background:** Philip Riedel was appointed to the Business Improvement District Board in June of 2012. Mr. Riedel resigned from the Board in October of 2012. Therefore, it is necessary to appoint one member to fill the remainder of his term.

Purpose

The Business Improvement District Board of Trustees consists of seven members appointed by the City Commission. Members must be owners of property within the boundaries of the Business Improvement District or their personal representative, agent, or guardian (MCA§7-12-1121). The B.I.D. oversees the functions, operations, management and administration as necessary to carry out the purposes and objectives of the Business Improvement District.
