Suggested Motion:

1. Commissioner moves:

“I move that the City Commission reappoint Ted Barnes to the Police Commission for a three-year term through June 30, 2015.”

2. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, inquiries from the public, and calls the vote.

Staff Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Commission reappoint Ted Barnes to the Police Commission for a three-year term, through June 30, 2015.

Background: Ted Barnes was appointed to the Police Commission in 2009. Mr. Barnes is interested in and eligible for reappointment.

Purpose

The Police Commission reviews all Police Department applicants for police officer positions and hears disciplinary appeals for the Police Department. The Commission is composed of three members appointed by the City Commission.

Concurrences: On March 6, 2012, the City Commission adopted Resolution 9962 Establishing a Policy Concerning Appointments to boards and Commissions, which states in part, “In the case of a member eligible for and interested in reappointment, if the member is in good standing and it is the recommendation of the board/commission, his application shall be brought before the Commission for consideration for reappointment without advertising for other citizen interest.”

The Police Department is recommending Mr. Barnes reappointment.
