Action Requested: Reappoint two members to the Tourism Business Improvement District

Suggested Motion:

1. Commissioner moves:

"I move that the City Commission reappoint Sandra Johnson-Thares and Malissa Hollan to the Tourism Business Improvement District Board of Trustees to four-year terms through June 30, 2017.

2. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, public comment, and calls the vote.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Commission appoint two members to the Tourism Business Improvement District Board of Trustees to four-year terms through June 30, 2017.

Background: The terms of Sandra Johnson-Thares and Malissa Hollan expire on June 30, 2013. Both Ms. Thares and Ms. Hollan are eligible for reappointment and that is the recommendation of the TBID Board.

Purpose

The Tourism Business Improvement District was established by Resolution 9792 on December 2, 2008. Its overall purpose is to utilize tax dollars through the T.B.I.D. assessment and direct those monies to be used for the purpose of promoting tourism, conventions, trade shows, and travel to the City of Great Falls. Trustees must be an owner of property within the District or their assignee.

Evaluation and Selection Process

No advertising was done since both members are eligible for and interested in reappointment.
