Purpose

International programs are growing for m any reasons. Rapid changes in communications technology, globalization of the ma rketplace, and political changes in the last decade have all contributed to an increasing awareness these trends will accelerate in the future. Communities, as well as individuals, businesses, and institutions will need to learn to participate in the "global village," or be left behind econom ically or in other ways. In order for the City to take a leadership role in nurturing and coordinating some of the international efforts, the Advisory Commission on International Re lationships was created by Ordinance 2788 on Novem ber 8, 2000, and amended by Ordinance 2863 on October 21, 2003. The Commission provides support,

coordination, and exchange of inform ation for international programs in the community. The Commission consists of nine to eleven members.
