Action Requested: Approve Change Order No. 1 and Final Payment

Suggested Motion:

1. Commissioner moves:

"I move that the City Commission approve Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$4,729.88 and approve Final Payment in the amount of \$14,336.83 to Detailed Construction Company and \$144.82 to the Montana State Miscellaneous Tax Fund for the Renovation of the 911 Center Phase 1 - O.F 1667."

2. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, public comment, and calls for the vote.

Staff Recommendation: Approve Change Order No. 1 and Final Payment.

Background: Detailed Construction Company was awarded the bid for the renovation of the 911 Center in September and completed the scope of work as outlined. During the process of the renovation, it was determined that more extensive repairs needed to be done to the roof to fix a leaky roof vent. In addition to the roof repairs, it is necessary to replace some of the door locks and strike plates in some of the other doors in the facility and remove a built in console that hindered installation of the dispatch consoles. These additions, along with the required city permit, account for the need for a change order.

Conclusion: City staff recommends approving Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$4,729.88 and recommends making the final payment to Detailed Construction Company.

Change Order

Instructions

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

This document was developed to provide a uniform format for handling contract changes that affect Contract Price or Contract Times. Changes that have been initiated by a Work Change Directives must be incorporated into a sub sequent Change Order if they affect Price or Times.

Changes that affect Contract Price or Contract Times should be promptly covered by a Change Order. The practice of accumulating Change Orders to reduce the administrative burden may lead to unnecessary disputes.

If Milestones have been listed in the Agreement, any effect of a Change Order thereon should be addressed.

For supplemental instructions and minor changes not involving a change in the Contract Price or Contract Times, an Field Order should be used.

B. COMPLETING THE CHANGE ORDER FORM

Engineer normally initiates the form, including a description of the changes involved and attachments based yupon documents and proposals submitted by Contractor, or requests from Owner, or both.

Once Engineer has completed and signed the form, all copies should be sent to Owner or Contractor for approval, depending on whether the Change Order is a true order to the Contractor or the formalization of a negotiated agreement for a previously performed change. After approval by one contracting party, all copies should be sent to the other party for approval. Engineer should make distribution of executed copies after approval by both parties.

If a change only applies to price or to times, cross out the part of the tabulation that does not apply.
