Background: The Pool Fund has been identified by the City Manager as an "At Risk Fund." From FY10 to FY13, the Pool Fund received \$414,389 annually in General Fund support to balance the Pool budget. This amount was reduced in FY14 to \$214,389 a reduction of \$200,000. This reduction in General Fund support was made up by utilizing the cash balance within the Pool Fund. With the Pool Fund cash balance being depleted this will not be an option in FY15. The proposed fee increase is projected to generate around \$85,000 towards the operations of the pools.

Mitchell Pool admission fees were last raised in 2001 (\$.50) and the Electric City Water Park pass fees were set with the addition of the Flow Rider. ECWP or Mitchell Pool fees have not been raised since 2001. Neighborhood pool fees were increase by \$.50 in 2002. In 2005 lap swimming fees and pool rental fees were increased slightly at the Natatorium.

Staff had recommended a fee increase for pools in 2009 which was denied by the City Commission.

Concurrences: The Park and Recreation Advisory Board recommended the City Commission adopt the new pool fees at their December 13, 2013 meeting.

Fiscal Impact: The proposed increases could generate up to \$85,000 in additional revenue for the swimming pools based on comparable attendance in 2013. (Revenues at the outdoor pools are weather dependent.)

Alternatives: Alternatives would include additional general fund subsidy or a reduction in services and/or facilities.

RESOLUTION NO. 10050

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SWIMMING POOL FEES FOR ELECTRIC CITY WATER PARK, WATER TOWER, JAYCEE, AND NATATORIUM SWIMMING POOLS

WHEREAS, the Park and Recreation Department's primary focus is to enhance the overall health and livability of our community; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution 9464, "A Resolution to Establish Swimming Pool Daily Fees for Mitchell, Water Tower, Jaycee, and Natatorium Swimming Pools" on March 15, 2005. Said fees have not been adjusted since that time; and

WHEREAS, having considered the cost of operation, administration and maintenance of all of the swimming pools, it is deemed necessary and appropriate to adjust fees associated therewith, thereby reducing the subsidy from the general fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

That Resolution 9464 is hereby repealed; and

Fees for the Electric City Water Park, Water Tower, Jaycee, and Natatorium swimming pools are hereby established as follows:
