Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends that the City Commission appoint one member to the Parking Advisory Commission for a three-year term through April 30, 2017.

Background: Phil Kiser was appointed to the Parking Advisory Commission (PAC) in December of 2008 and reappointed in 2011. Mr. Kiser resigned from the PAC in April of 2013. Heidi Propp was appointed in February of 2013. Ms. Propp did not meet the attendance policy required to remain on the PAC. There are currently two vacancies on the PAC. Advertising has been on-going for persons interested in serving. At this time, one application has been received.

Purpose.

The Parking Advisory Commission is comprised of five members appointed by the City Commission. The Commission advises the City Commission, City Manager, and Planning and Community Development Staff on matters related to parking issues within the Parking Districts.
