**Suggested Motion:**

1. Commissioner moves:

“I move that the City Commission reappoint Mark Johnson as a non-league representative for a three-year term through March 31, 2017.”

2. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, public comment, and calls the vote.

**Staff Recommendation:** It is recommended that the City Commission reappoint Mark Johnson to the Golf Advisory Board.

**Background:** The term of Mark Johnson expires on March 31, 2014. Mr. Johnson is interested in reappointment to the Board.

Resolution 10059 Establishing a Policy Concerning Appointments to Boards and Commissions, which was adopted on March 4, 2014, states, “In the case of a member eligible for and interested in reappointment, if the member is in good standing and it is the recommendation of the board/commission, his application shall be brought before the Commission for consideration for reappointment without advertising for other citizen interest.” At its February 24, 2014, meeting, the Golf Advisory Board recommended the reappointment of Mark Johnson.

Consideration for this reappointment was brought before the City Commission at its March 4, 2014, City Commission meeting; however, the item was inadvertently overlooked and no action was taken at that time.

Purpose

The Golf Advisory Board is comprised of five members with representation from the City Men's Golf Association, City Women's Golf Association, Malmstrom Golf Association, and two Non-

league golfers. The Board advises the City Commission regarding the operation of municipal golf courses. Members must reside within the City limits.

Evaluation and Selection Process

No advertising was done for this opening.
