Item:	Appointments to the Community Development Council

Action Requested:	Appoint members for three-year terms to the Community Development Council.
Suggested Motion:	
1. Commissioner moves:	
"I move that the City Commission appoint, and to three-year terms through October 31, 2017, to the Community Development Council."	
2. Mayor calls for a second, discussion, public comment, and calls the vote.	

Staff Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Commission appoint members to the Community Development Council for three-year terms through October 31, 2017.

Background: The terms of Carrie Koppy, Sandie Wright and Anita Fisher expired on October 31, 2014. Ms. Koppy and Ms. Wright are not eligible for reappointment, and Ms. Fisher is eligible for, but not interested in being reappointed. Therefore, it is necessary to appoint three members to the Community Development Council.

Press Releases were done on October 8, November 3, and November 25, 2014, and the openings were also posted on the City of Great Falls website. Two **Three** applications have been received at this time. Staff will continue to seek additional interested citizens.

Purpose

To ensure citizen participation in the CDBG allocation process, a ten-member volunteer advisory board is appointed by the City Commission. The Community Development Council makes funding recommendations for projects applying for CDBG funding to the City Commission. Members must live within the city limits.

Evaluation and Selection Process

Advertising was done through a press release to the local media and on the City of Great Falls Website. Two Three applications were received.
