Item: One New 2016 Combination Broom & Vacuum Street Sweeper

Action Requested: Award Bid

Suggested Motion:

1. Commissioner moves:

"I move that the City Commission (approve/reject) the bid award for one new 2016 Elgin Whirlwind Pete 220 combination broom & vacuum street sweeper to Titan Machinery of Great Falls for \$274,269.37, including trade-in."

2. Mayor requests a second to the motion, Commission discussion, public comment, and calls for the vote.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends that the City Commission award the bid for one new 2016 Elgin Whirlwind Pete 220 combination broom & vacuum street sweeper to Titan Machinery of Great Falls for \$274,269.37, including trade-in.

Background:

Purpose

This unit will be used in the Street Division.

Evaluation and Selection Process

The specifications were advertised two times in the Great Falls Tribune, placed on the City of Great Falls website, and mailed to eight prospective bidders. The bids were opened on March 2, 2016 with three bidders responding, one with no bid.

The low bid is a regenerative air sweeper and not a vacuum sweeper as the bid specifications stated. Staff traveled to Helena to demo the Schwarze A7. A regenerative air sweeper is used for parking lots and areas with dry material. This type of sweeper is not effective as a main stream sweeper. A broom & vacuum sweeper is essential for sweeping areas with compacted material, leaves, and other debris.

Staff recommends accepting the trade-in offer of \$12,000 for the City's 2002 Elgin Whirlwind, VIN #49HAADBV53DK98851, Unit #840.

Conclusion

The bid by Titan Machinery is not the low bid but meets the specifications and is under the budgeted amount for the combination broom & vacuum street sweeper.

Fiscal Impact: Funds for this purchase were provided in the FY 15/16 Street Budget.

Alternatives: The City Commission could vote to reject the bids for the purchase of this new 2016 combination broom & vacuum street sweeper.
