**Suggested Motion:**

**Staff Recommendation:** Staff recommends that the City Commission reappoint Kenny Volk to the Parking Advisory Commission for a three-year term through April 30, 2019.

**Summary:** Kenny Volk was appointed to the Parking Advisory Commission in November of 2015 to fill the remainder of a three year term that will expire April 30, 2016. Mr. Volk is interested in serving another three year term.

**Background:**

The Parking Advisory Commission is comprised of five members appointed by the City Commission. The Commission advises the City Commission, City Manager, and Planning and Community Development Staff on matters related to parking issues within the Parking Districts.

Evaluation and Selection Process

In accordance to Resolution 10059, members eligible for and interested in reappointment, if member is in good standing and it is the recommendation of the board/commission, his application shall be brought before the Commission for consideration for reappointment without advertising for other citizen interest.
