Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Commission appoint one new member to the Tourism Business Improvement District Board of Trustees to the remainder of a four-year term through June 30, 2019.

Background:

Ryan Carroll was appointed to the Board in July 2015 and has resigned effective July 5, 2016. Therefore, it is necessary to appoint one member to fill Mr. Carroll's vacancy.

Purpose

The Tourism Business Improvement District (TBID) was established by Resolution 9792 on December 2, 2008. Its overall purpose is to utilize tax dollars through the TBID assessment and direct those monies to be used for the purpose of promoting tourism, conventions, trade shows, and travel to the City of Great Falls. Trustees must be an owner of property within the TBID or their assignee.

Evaluation and Selection Process

Announcement of the opening was done through a letter sent to the members within the Tourism Business Improvement District.
