Action Requested: Award Bid

Suggested Motion:

1. Commissioner moves:

"I move that the City Commission (approve/reject) the bid award for gasoline and diesel fuel to Mountain View Co-op for three years at an annual cost of approximately \$537,428, and authorize the City Manager to execute the contract documents."

2. Mayor calls for a second to the motion, Commission discussion, public comment, and calls for the vote.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends that the City Commission award the gasoline and diesel fuel contract to Mountain View Co-op for three years at an annual cost of approximately \$537,428, and authorize the City Manager to execute the contract documents.

Background:

Significant Impacts

Per the existing contract, the parties involved by mutual agreement can extend the contract for a period of three years.

Staff estimates the annual fuel use to be 140,000 gallons of unleaded gasoline, 24,000 gallons of number one diesel and 126,000 gallons of number two diesel.

Fuel prices will, of course, fluctuate and the specifications ask for the particular index the supplier proposes to use to determine the cost changes. Mountain View Co-op will use the Cenex wholesale price, and as the price paid by Mountain View Co-op changes, our price will change by the same amount per gallon.

Evaluation and Selection Process

The specifications were advertised two times in the Great Falls Tribune, placed on the City of Great Falls website, and mailed to six prospective bidders. The bids were opened on August 17, 2016, with one bidder responding.

Fiscal Impact: The costs per gallon decreased significantly:

Funds for the purchase of gasoline and diesel fuels are provided in individual department budgets. Central Garage tracks fuel usage and departments are billed for their actual use.

Alternatives: The City Commission could vote to reject this bid award.

CITY OF GREAT FALLS INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR FUEL PURCHASE

1.0 INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

- 1.1 <u>Bids:</u> All bids shall be made on the attached forms provided by the City of Great Falls (City). All bids shall be legibly written in ink.
- 1.2 <u>Delivery of Bid:</u> Each bid must be signed and submitted in a sealed envelope. Envelope containing bid shall be addressed to the City Clerk, 2 Park Drive South, Civic Center Room 204, Great Falls, MT 59401, and plainly marked on the outside with the statement, "<u>Bid for Fuel Purchase</u>." Signed and sealed bids are due no later than 3:00 pm, Wednesday, August 17, 2016. Bids will be opened in the Civic Center Rainbow Room at 3:00 pm, Wednesday, August 17, 2016.
- 1.3 Bid and Performance Guarantee: Bids must be accompanied by a cashier's check, certified check, or bank money order and issued by a national banking association located in the State of Montana, or by any banking corporation incorporated in the State of Montana; or by a bid bond or bonds executed by the Surety Corporation authorized to do business in the State of Montana in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid as a guarantee will be returned to bidder.
- 1.4 <u>Rejection of Bid</u>: The City of Great Falls reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to accept any bid deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Great Falls.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR FUEL PURCHASE

It is the intent of these specifications and bid proposal to secure price quotes for Unleaded Gasoline (minimum of 85 Octane) and No. 1 and No. 2 Diesel Fuel (Cetane 45 and 43, respectively) for the City of Great Falls for a three-year period beginning with City Commission bid award. THIS AGREEMENT MAY BE AUTOMATICALLY RENEWED BY MUTUAL AGREEMENT OF THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS AND THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR AN ADDITIONAL THREE YEAR TERM. THE PARTY DESIRING TO EXTEND THIS AGREEMENT SHALL PROVIDE AT LEAST 180 DAYS PRIOR WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE OTHER. Fuel products must meet or exceed all the following specifications. Any deletions or variations from the following specifications must be noted and explained. These specifications shall be construed as minimum requirements.
