### **Suggested Motion:**

#### 1. Commissioner moves:

"I move that the City Commission (adopt/not adopt) the 2016/2017 Amended Annual Action Plan, including the changes in project scope for Great Falls Park & Recreation, Center for Mental Health, and Park Manor as recommended, and (authorize/not authorize) the submittal to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)."

2. Mayor requests a second to the motion, Commission discussion, public comment, and calls for the vote.

**Staff Recommendation:** The Planning and Community Development staff recommends that the City Commission adopt the proposed Amended Annual Action Plan and authorize submittal to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

**Summary:** The 2016/2017 Amended Annual Action Plan includes changes to the scope/projects of the following CDBG grant recipients; Great Falls Park & Recreation, Center for Mental Health, and Park Manor. Great Falls Park & Recreation requests to reallocate funds for an immediate need to repair the floor in the women's locker room at Morony Natatorium. The Center for Mental Health and Park Manor are both requesting to change their scope/projects because they initiated work on their facilities prior to City staff conducting environmental review, projects awarded funding in the original 2016/2017 Annual Action Plan were no longer eligible to receive funds. City staff wanted to make sure both entities still received Federal funding for facility needs, project changes are being brought forward with the Amended Plan.

**Background:** The Annual Action Plan portion of the Consolidated Plan includes the proposed use of CDBG and HOME funds for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. The Consolidated Plan is a five

year comprehensive planning strategy required by HUD. The 2016/2017 Annual Action Plan will be the second year of this five year plan.

<u>Citizen Participation:</u> A 30-day comment period beginning January 2, 2017, through January 31, 2017, was established to receive citizen input on the proposed 2016/2017 Amended Annual Action Plan. Notice of the Annual Action Plan Amendment was published in the *Great Falls Tribune* on December 26, 2016, January 1, 2017, and in the *Consumers Press* on December 29, 2016. A copy of the proposed Amended Annual Action Plan has been available for review in the City's Planning and Community Development Department Office, the Great Falls Public Library, and on the City of Great Falls web page.

Following the 30 day public comment period, the final Amended Annual Action Plan will be submitted to HUD. The final Annual Action Plan will be on file in the City Clerk's office.

**Fiscal Impact:** Funding does not include use of monies from the City Budget. The proposed improvements to Morony Natatorium will not increase or decrease the budget for the Park and Recreation Department. In fact, the improvements to the locker room floor and potentially the doors of the facility will relieve pressure on using City general fund monies. Other than this minor amendment, CDBG funding will follow the City Commission and Community Development Council's March 15, 2016, approved funding allocations.

**Alternatives:** The City Commission may choose to approve the 2016/2017 Amended Annual Action Plan as presented, amend the proposed changes, or reject the amendment. This would disallow 2016/2017 CDBG funding to the Center for Mental Health and Park Manor.
