- **Domestic Animal**: GFPD Animal Control (*To report an active domestic animal incident, call the non-emergency police dispatch line at* (406) 455-8599.)
- Noise: GFPD
- Snow Removal: on public sidewalks = Planning & Community Development; on public streets = Public Works
- ADA Compliance: Sidewalks = Public Works; Public Buildings = Planning & Community Development; Parks = Park & Recreation
- Road/Traffic: Public Works
- Boulevard Trees: Park & Recreation
- Park Maintenance: Park & Recreation
- Other TBD based on the issue
