DISCUSSION

Medical Director Dr. Stowers noted that he had attended a National Conference where the issue of transport or not transporting non-emergent patients came up. It was the consensus of this group that there needs to be a solution, but at this time none exists. The Board determined that the work of not transporting a patient who wanted to be transported would not save time or resources. Additionally, the liability would be too great to risk not transporting a pt.

It was also discussed that there may be some alternatives to taking non emergent patients to the ER but to some other facility that could better support the needs of these customers.

CONCLUSIONS

This issue is tabled for now. However, if best practices or laws change this issue would resurrected and changes may be made to prevent transporting patients to

Recently, this has become a problem. If west campus has an emergent patient the medical staff is to dail 1111 to get internal staff responding. The internal operator then calls 911. Usually this person can not give any details as to what is wrong with the emergent pt.
