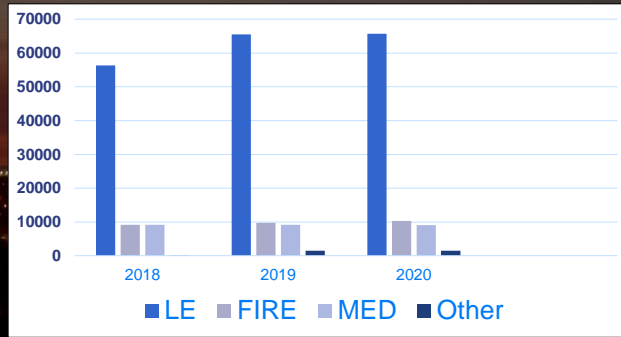

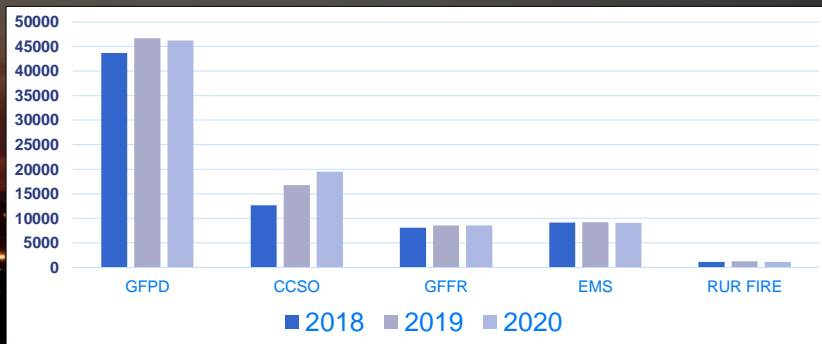

Calls to 911 Center decreased in 2020, likely due to on-line reporting and COVID

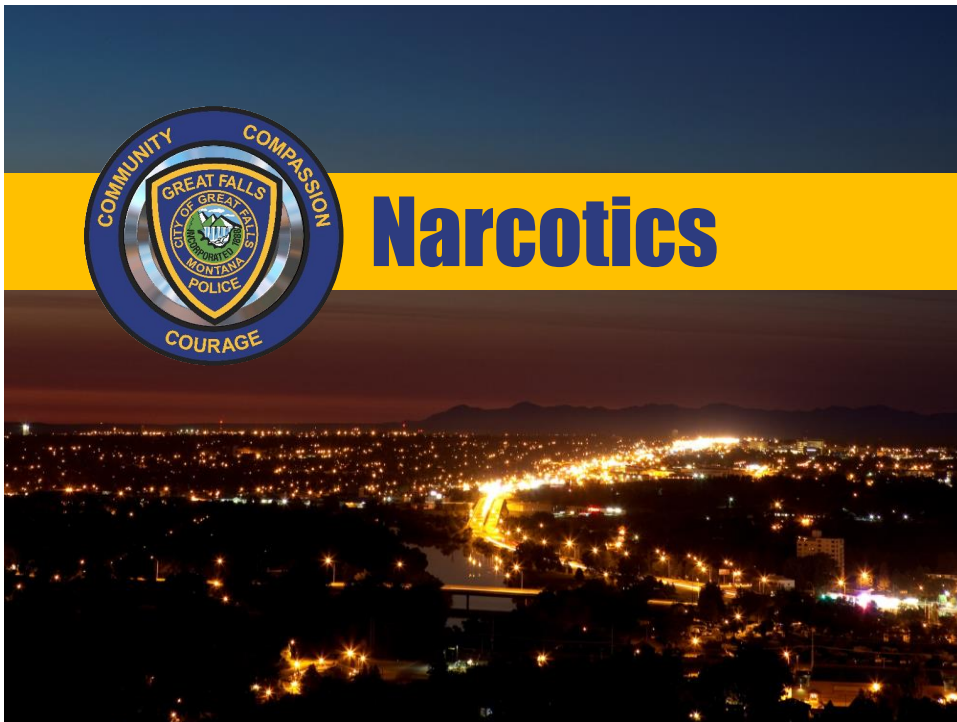
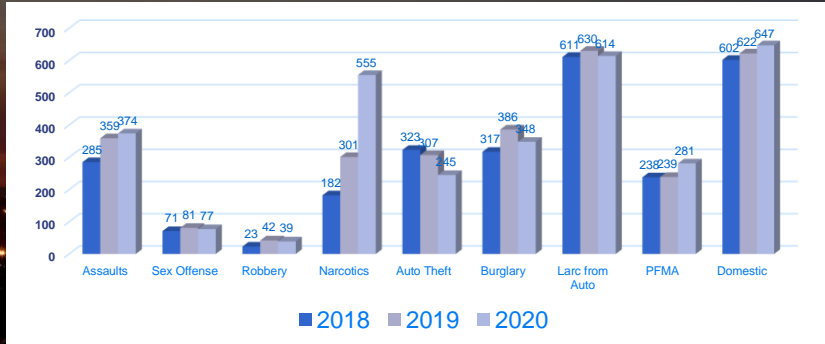

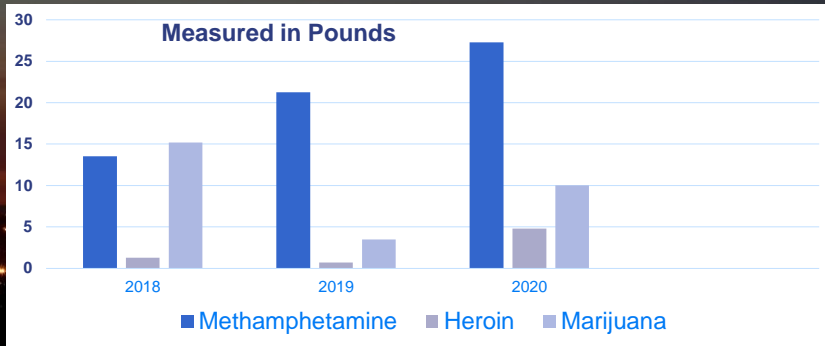
Reported Crimes

Narcotics Seizures

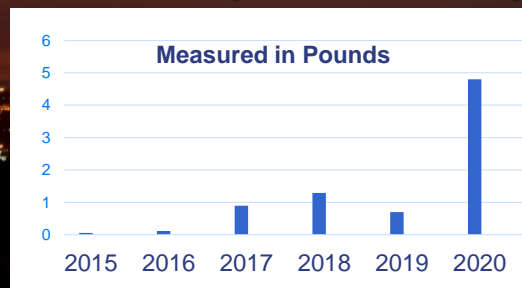


2.34 pounds of cocaine seized over the three-year period, with the majority seized in 2019 (2.28 lbs)



Heroin Seizures

2020: 4.80 pounds of Heroin was seized, preventing 21,791 doses from being consumed by our community.

Lethal dose of Heroin versus Fentanyl

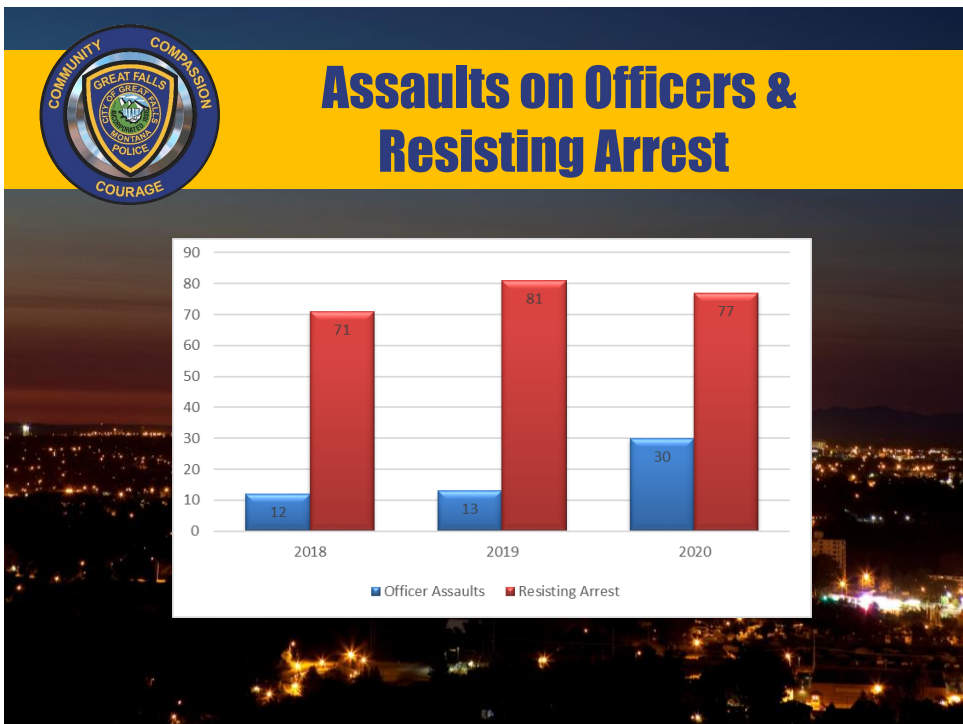
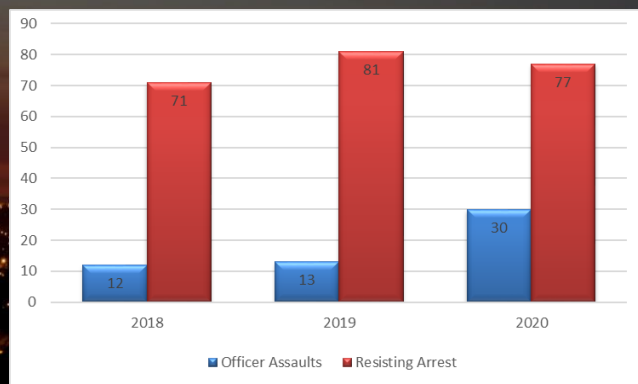
