Bystanders can help save lives



CHAIN OF Survival

Recognize Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA)

If a person is unresponsive and not breathing, call 911.

Call 911

Call 911 to get help. Follow 911 dispatcher's instructions.

Start CPR

Start CPR to triple the chance of survival. Press hard and fast at the center of the chest (100-120 compressions/minute.

Use AED

Use an automated external defibrillator (AED) to restart the heart. Follow step-by-step audio/visual instructions.

EMS Response

Transfer care to emergency medical services professionals, who will provide advanced life support.

Hospital Care

Hospital professionals will continue integrated post-cardiac care.



AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)

AEDs may be seen in many public offices and buildings and are used to help those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest.

AEDs are an easy-to-use medical device that can analyze the heart's rhythm, and if necessary, deliver an electric shock to restore the heart rhythm to normal.

Chances of survival from sudden cardiac death decrease by 7-10% for each minute without immediate CPR of defibrillation. After 10 minutes, resuscitation rarely succeeds.

AEDs can be lifesaving tools that must be maintained. Maintenance schedules are crucial to keep the device functioning properly.
