FIRE PREVENTION

MAJOR CAUSES OF STRUCTURE FIRES

18 fires were the result of *Food Unattended on Stove*.

7 fires were the result of *Appliances*.

6 fires were the result of *Careless Smoking*.

PROPERTY VALUE & LOSS

The estimated value of the structures (66) involved in fires in 2015 was \$21,941,000.

The total estimated property damage was \$1,364,592.

This equates to a loss of 6.22%.

Of the 66 structure fires, 54 fires were confined to the room or area of origin, 9 were confined to the structure itself and 2 extended beyond the structure.
