A TIIP grant request has been submitted for roof replacement and interpretive signage and the HPAC submitted a letter of support for the request.

Sheree Nelson's designs for the 2011 ornament, featuring the Ursuline Centre, were presented and the HPAC selected a design. Ken Robison made the motion to select the design and have 500 numbered and dated ornaments produced. Kelly seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
