

Neighborhood Council 4 Minutes

Chair Sandra called the meeting to order at 6:31pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business:

Jerry McKinley discussed in detail several traffic concerns, and answered various questions from the council and neighbors.

- After inquiring of the council's opinion, Jerry will mark 7th Avenue South between 46th and 57th streets as a thru street since most motorists are already treating this roadway as such.
- Based upon comments, Jerry will review 46th and Ella Avenue.
- Because a previous study conducted earlier this year indicated that several children use 36th Street and 1st Avenue South as a school crosswalk, Jerry is considering marking this location as a crosswalk for safety purposes.

Neighborhood Concerns:

Resident John Beer of 3825 5th Avenue South expressed concerns about the increase in congestion and safety issues at Lewis and Clark Elementary when parents drop off and pick up their children from school. He has some ideas about how the problems could be mitigated. Sandra will find out who should be involved in the discussion and will notify John when the topic will be on the agenda.

Other Business:

Sandra announced that the next Council of Council meeting will be on Tuesday, May 23 at 7:00 p.m. All are invited.

Sandra also announced that May's agenda will include Community Policing Officer, Clint Houston, and a gang presentation by Sgt. Jeff Beecroft, GFPD.

Old Business:

Gregg made a motion to accept the March minutes as presented. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
