Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 7:12PM.

Old Business:

Faith Lutheran Church – No speaker was present. The church is finished and services are being held.

Grand Vista park – Casey Furr gave an update of activities. Progress is being made and fund raising continues.

Traffic data requested by Mr. Robert Drga has been obtained and provided to him.

Reference Mr Harry Kokko's concern about vehicles parked near intersections, the Chief of Police has appointed two officers to assess the problem throughout the city with action to be based on the results.

New Business:

Sandy Rice briefed details about the Downtown Safety Alliance. She explained the goals of the alliance noting that it has been in existence for 18 months. She provided attendees handouts with information about the effort.

Mr. Steven McCabe related his concerns about proposed school redistricting. His primary concern is the possibility that students currently attending Meadowlark Elementary School would be bused to West Elementary. He was advised of a number of ways to make his concerns known to the school district including a public meeting to be held on 12 December.
