- November meeting minutes read and approved.
  
- Old Business:
  - Police Advisory Report:  
Scott Miranti informed the council regarding the departments receipt of a new vehicle and grants. Noted an increase in drug related crime.
  
- New Business:
  - Lincoln School:  
Jerry McKinley from the traffic division reviewed the request by Gary Schoenthal regarding a proposed radar speed sign at Lincoln school. Mr. McKinley said the city would allow the sign on the city right of way on 26<sup>th</sup> street south, but the school would have to install it on their own.   - Rezone and sale of park land – Alfred Insurance request:  
Tom Micuda from GF City Planning dept. informed the council of details regarding the possible sale of a portion of Lions park to allow Alfred Insurance to install an elevator to the west side of their building. The sale price for the 12' x 130' property was set at \$9000 and would require rezoning to commercial. The council noted that this would set a possible precedent. No objection was made by the public in attendance. A motion was made and passed 4 to 1 to support the sale.
