

**NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL #6 MEETING – Sunnyside School Library

He also stated garbage dumpsters in the alley are usually overflowing onto the ground causing neighborhood litter. He noted a couch has been sitting in the alley for several months and asked what could be done to address these issues. Cherry Loney said she would notify GFPD Officer Don Gerhart about the speeding and the City Community Decay officer about garbage and the couch and get back to Mr. Guy.

Jason Olthoff, 2513 Castle Pines Way noted law enforcement is at a house on his street 2-3 times each week.
