# **Neigbor Corcerns**

Mike Wedekind, a member of the Planning Board, appeared as a private citizen. He asked that the the city consider raising the speed limit on 36<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE to 35mph. Increased traffic since recent construction makes it a well used exit to Bootlegger Trail and on into GF. When 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave. Is completed, that, too, will provide egress out of the newer area north of the water tower. Jerry McKinley, traffic supervisor noted that urban speed limits by state law is 25mph but that cities have some flexibility. A study of that area was discussed. Tim Austin moved and and Max Mauch seconded a motion to request a study from the city of the traffic and speed limit options for that NW/NE area. Motion passed.

MT House Candidates, Alex Rosendale and Lola Sheldon-Galloway introduced themselves, appreciated listening to what was happening in our area. Mr. Rosendale, developer of Eagle's Crossing, reported that it continues to grow.
