Chair Lisa Meyers brought the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Old Business: Mark Willmarth - Strategic Visioning

Mark took the Council through a process designed to achieve clarity and alignment regarding the Council's vision for Neighborhood #7 for the next one to three years.

Mark reviewed the April meeting and what we talked about at that meeting, He handed out the notes from that meeting for us to work with as a starting point. (Attached)

Mark suggested that we create a one page document with "What" we do, "Why" we do it, "Our Beliefs" and the goals we set for the next 1-3 years.

He cautioned us to be aware of what we have control over and what we don't have control over. For instance, we can control what advice and recommendations we give our government entities, but we do not control the laws. We can impact our lawmakers with our views, however.

A good discussion ensued on how to engage our neighbors to implement our beliefs and goals. A neighborhood newsletter and "whom to call" update could be distributed. Personal engagement with neighbors as we walk the neighborhood was suggested.

When we run into a roadblock and a problem seems beyond solution, Mark suggested asking ourselves: "What else can we do to address the problem?"

After much discussion, we came up with 13 questions we need to respond to be successful in our 1-3 years vision for Neighborhood #7. (Attached)

We also came up with a work in progress, subject to edit and revision, a one page document that lists Why, What, Beliefs, and Goals. (Attached)
