- Acknowledge City Manager Greg Doyon for attending our September meeting and personally following up on neighborhood concerns expressed.

**NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS:**

Emma White, 1624 19<sup>th</sup> St. So., mentioned an uptick in neighborhood thefts possibly stemming from a house on 17<sup>th</sup> Ave. So., which she believes may be occupied by homeless people.

Cherry Loney mentioned a couple more discarded mattresses have appeared in the alley between 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> St. So. Lanni said she would pass the information along to the City Sanitation Department.
