7:00 PM meeting called to order by Barney Danishefsky.

Old Business:

- March meeting minutes read. Scott motioned and Shannon seconded. Public was asked to comment: none. Unanimously approved.
- Kranz Park: Steve Herrig called Barney last week. There may be a deal in the near future that includes a land swap that may get Kranz Park its playground equipment and more.

Other Business:

- Council #9's City Commission Update – Work Session – slated for December 1, 2020. Jeff Lauver designated to attend.
- October 27, 2020: council of council meeting. Will include discussion of a public nuisance ordinance.

New Business:

- Neighborhood concerns over the summer: Barney reported 3 phone calls: a) treehouse on 26th street, b) neighbor is unhappy with GFHS re-opening and the COVID-19 spreading, c) garbage pick-up during the power line repairs – they wanted a refund on that week's fees for pick-up. Scott reported issues with the fireworks over the 4th of July weekend; also break-ins in the neighborhood. Karen reported crimes on the 8th Avenue S. alley.

Neighborhood Concerns:

- ???? said that there are street lights out near her address and that she has reported it, they were fixed, but almost immediately went back out. Two of the lights are on GFHS property, so she will contact the administration about them. Scott mentioned that it took around 45 days to get one near his home repaired.
