Planning and Community Development Department 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan for HUD-Funded Programs

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) allocates funding annually to the City of Great Falls to address housing and community development needs through its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME). This funding positively impacts low and moderate income people in our community through programs and services provided by the City and area organizations and businesses. The City expects to receive \$810,605 (CDBG) and \$283,494 (HOME) for Program Year 2021, which begins July 1, 2021 and ends June 30, 2022.



CDBG and HOME Program 5-Year Goals

Public Services	 Provide support to public service agencies' operating programs that benefit low to moderate income persons.
Affordable Housing	 Increase and preserve affordable housing opportunities for very low to moderate income renters, homeowners, first-time homebuyers, and those experiencing homelessness; includes the removal of slum and blighted properties.
Housing Rehabilitation	 Provide construction and rehabilitation assistance for very low to moderate income homeowners, rental property owners and the Public Housing Authority.
Fair Housing	 Provide funding for activities that affirmatively further fair housing, including fair housing education, counseling, outreach, and referrals.
Economic Development	 Provide funding for projects which create decent paying jobs with benefits for persons from low to moderate income households.
Public Facilities & Improvements	• Provide public facility and infrastructure assistance, including handicap accessibility, energy efficiency improvements, and removal of slum and blighted properties to provide a suitable living environment.
