Great Falls Police Department presentation by CPT John Schaffer. He discussed a study completed by the Billings Police department that studied chronic utilizers of the criminal justice system, Fire and EMT services, the court system and the Healthcare system. They spent approximately \$10 million on 93 people and each person cost the city of Billings \$111,000+ per person. Great Falls, using similar criteria, said we have 24 people that have created the same drain on our systems in the City of Great Falls. The City Police Department is working to address the chronic utilizers with an alternate treatment cycle.

OTHER BUSINESS

• NeighborWorks Community clean-up of Sunnyside Park was tabled because it does not need any clean up.

PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS

- Don Ryan, county commissioner provided an overview of county operations, decisions and issues facing them. They are working on the same issues as the city police department in trying to address chronic offenders in different ways to reduce the drain on county resources.
