- Kranz Park: Steve Herrig reported to Shannon that work should begin shortly on the playground equipment and a pavilion on the NE side of the park, east of the large trees.
- Dan Barnett: asked about the possible upcoming city levies (safety and library). We suggested he attend the City Commission meetings.
- Judy White asked about the sidewalks planned for Kranz Park.
- Shannon attended the January 17th city commission meeting: she spurred the commission to start a new growth plan. She is also attending the Sheriffs Citizen's Academy.
