Judy asked about the locked gates and the property lane and fence line between the practice field and the park. Barney explained the verbal agreement with the school district.

- Tony Leppellere: 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue S: watermain replacement has left the road a mess. Barney said that he would contact the street department.
- Judy White: students are hiding in the lilac bushes in her alley and doing nefarious things. Barney suggested putting up "No Trespassing" signs. We recommended during the year she informs the GFHS resource officer know of the issue.
