Neighborhood Council #6 Minutes for Wednesday, March 6th, 2024 Sunnyside School Library

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Spectrum crosswalk will be painted this spring when the weather allows
- Kevin Vining provided an estimate of \$2610 to seal coat and paint new lines on the Sunnyside Park Basketball Court. The balance in our account is \$2654.63. A motion to approve the work was made by Rick and second by Tad. Motion carried 4/0.
- Tad will take written notes for the minutes of NC6 neighborhood council meetings. Rick will type them up and forward them to Lanni and Carl.
- Carl has been trying to contact Northwest Energy regarding the streetlight on 17 th Ave So and 7 th Street So. He will continue to work on contacting them.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Vandalism at the Warden Park gazebo. Kevin Vaning outlined the steps the city takes on a regular basis to repair city park property damaged by vandalism. One issue is that parts for telescoping viewer, playground equipment, etc. are hard to obtain because the equipment is dated. Replacement costs are high.
- Three street issues were discussed and a call will be made to Eric Boyd, the City Street and Traffic manager
 - Drainage of private property runoff on 13th Avenue between 7th and 9th street.
 During the winter, the drainage pools on the street and creates a lot of ice on the road. The constant runoff also damaged the asphalt on the street.
 - There is also constant private property water runoff from the Condos on 13th Ave and 4th street that damages the asphalt. The city recently repaired the asphalt and there is a concern that the constant runoff will damage the new work done.
 - Parking on the hill on 13th Ave on the south side of Warden park has been an issue. It is a blind hill and when cars are parked on both sides of the street there is only room for one-way traffic on a blind hill. Eric said he was going to ask the police to take a look at it and it appears parking habits have been addressed.
