NEW BUSINESS:

Bob Meyers, Director the Senior Citizen's Center, gave a comprehensive presentation detailing the history and services provided by the Center. The Center was opened in 1968 by members of the Opportunities Incorporated Board of Directors and in 1971 was taken over by the County. In 1993 it became a separate 501-C3 non-profit and in 1996 Bob Meyer was hired.

The center is open seven days a week providing a wide range of activities from exercise classes to bingo and much much more, as well as breakfast and Thursday evening dinner. It costs \$320,000 annually to operate the Center. Membership is \$20 per year.
