 - Additionally, Jesse Slaughter discussed the city/county relationship at the jail and the distribution of funds and overcrowding. He's trying to get lowlevel prisoners released pre-trial to save money.
 - Crime-Mapping has been bought out by another company and is changing and may be discontinued.
