Patty Cadwell, 2620 2nd Ave N commented that bids have been received. Anita Fisher was on the CDBG committee; she stated it would most likely come from the general fund.


Commissioner Mary Jolley, 1910 2nd Ave N, commented on the CDBG grant process and stated that the improvements possibly may come under bid as well.

Sandra Guynn commented that the current playground equipment is expected to be removed July; and if the CDBG grant is approved by the City Commission, installation of new playground structures would commence in October or November 2012.

Members of NC4 voted unanimously in favor of CDBG grant funding improvements to Pinski Park.
