Committee Reports:

Police Advisory Board: Robin reports they continue to pursue the feasibility of moving the call center to the Adult Detention Facility. Costs are a major factor. In particular, the cost to relocate the server is high. A Citizens Police Academy will start soon.

Pearson Addition SID: City personnel recently convened the work group for a meeting, although no one who attended is present at the Council meeting to provide a report.

Upper/Lower River Road Drainage: Work continues on a resolution. City staff will meet with property owners for a status update in early 2013.

Council of Councils: No report.

Complaint from Linda Stirling, 1375 13th Ave SW, #12, Re Rental Property on 13th St. So: Nick followed up with Officer Brian Slavik. The complaint has been turned over to Officer Pam Henry and a file has been opened on the property. Linda and her tenant, Justin Cockrell, 1413 13th St. So., were present and provided additional information describing fights, loud music, screaming, etc. that tenants in neighboring properties are regularly subjected to. The Council advised sending a letter to the property owner requesting her to resolve the issues and to consistently file a police report on each incident. Once initiated, the Neighborhood Watch program will be helpful in mitigating this problem.

New Business:

By unanimous ballot, the following Neighborhood Council 6 officers were elected for the 2013 term: Chairman, Robin Baker Vice Chairman, Nick Bourdeau Secretary, Cherry Loney

The representative to Council of Councils was postponed till January to provide time to talk with Carl Donovan about his continued interest/availability to serve.

Neighborhood Watch and Community Policing will be discussed at the January meeting.
