(this avenue will be constructed along with the apartments) 214 units are planned, containing approximately 730 ft<sup>2</sup>, sold a market rate of \$1.00/ft<sup>2</sup>; a club house of about 3500 ft<sup>2</sup> with a pool, health & fitness, and other recreational facilities.

The first reading will be a the City Commission meeting Sept 3

The Public Hearing will be held October 1.
