The idea is a free exchange of books – take a book, leave a book. It operates completely on the honor system, using excess or surplus books from the library, and from donated books. She would like to see one *Little Free Library* in each of the nine neighborhood councils throughout the city. It's a program that has seen a lot of success throughout the U.S. She said vandalism has not been much of a problem. She asked if Council #1 would support the program. Bill Thomas made a motion to support the program, second by Lynda Sowell, and approved unanimously by council members. Kathy will work with the Parks and Rec. Department to determine placement, although the Council thought Meadowlark Park on Fox Farm Road and Park Garden Road would be a good location. Jay asked Kathy how she plans to promote the program, and Kathy indicated they will do this through signs, flyers, facebook, and the newspaper. They hope to start in Spring, 2014.

Other Business

- The February 11 meeting date at Meadowlark School will not work because of Parent Teacher conferences. The Council did not choose an alternate date, but will take this up at its January meeting.
- The swearing-in ceremony for city commission and neighborhood council members will take place Tuesday December 17 in the Gibson Room at the Civic Center.
- Entry Door to Meadowlark School: we have seen some confusion as to which door will remain open for council meetings. Due to safety issues, the school prefers that the door by the parking lot remain locked, and that we use the front door instead.
