Scott Patera from NorthWestern Energy gave a brief overview of the upgrade to its Great Falls Eastside Substation which is near Clara Park. The substation will be moved a short distance to the west and be realigned. NorthWestern is working with the City of Great Falls to exchange and purchase a small piece of property to accommodate the new substation. A public meeting is scheduled for October 6th.

Brad Livingston provided a brief overview of the State's disaster and emergency services. He informed us that the City has hired a consultant to help develop a master plan and public meetings will commence in November.
