NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL #8 MINUTES—June 16, 2016

Meeting was called to order at 6 pm by Chairman Karen Grove as we joined in the pledge to the flag. All five council members were present. Two community adults, and three guests who presented the program, were in attendance.

Reports:

Robin Schreiner gave the <u>Police Advisory Committee</u> report. The budget was discussed. DACTS guidelines (Data Driven Approach to Crime and Traffic Safety) were reviewed. Need for more officers and cameras. Hope to add a camera for each police car, six per year. Each camera is \$5000. Everything on camera is stored.

Council of Councils was May 24. It was not well attended. Park and Rec reported on the survey recently completed indicating which areas need the most resources.

Patty Cadwell restated that all written notes for the minutes need to be kept until after they have been approved.

New Business:

Three officials from the Great Falls Fire and Rescue Department, Jason Furr, Mike and Jason gave a presentation on the history and work of this department. A power point presentation and a question and answer session were very informative. BLS Basic Life Support and Advance Life Support teams were identified as well as why the ambulance and the fire department often arrive on the scene for a 911 call. Mandatory exercise is important for the health and well being of the Fire and Rescue teams. We also learned that they have a 95% higher chance of having cancer due to the conditions their bodies experience in fighting fires.

Flowers in Memorial Park were planted by Karen Grove and Mary Jolley. Bundi Gardens provided annuals for planting by the flag pole. A new flag was purchased by the city,
