Established in 1997, Neighborhood Councils operate within the City as advisory bodies to City staff, the City Commission, and residents of their districts. The Councils act as liaisons between residents and their city government conveying successes and concerns back and forth. Neighborhood Council (NC) meetings take place monthly in a location within each Council's district.


